Introduction

Consultants are critical to each BMI Healthcare hospital. However in common with most private healthcare operators, BMI Healthcare does not employ these consultants. Instead, consultants working in our hospitals are essentially self-employed practitioners who see and treat patients at our hospitals under the terms of our 'credentialing' or 'practising privileges' policy.

It is important that we are transparent about our relationship with our consultants and therefore via our corporate webpages and below, we have set out some of the ways in which we work together.

Higher Value Services

Consultants are charged £20 per hour for using consulting rooms at this hospital, except in relation to NHS patients.

We charge £706 per month for consultants using space arranged by the hospital for their own medical secretaries.

Lower Value Services

We provide a number of support services to our consultants, for which we do not make a charge. Further details are provided via our corporate webpages.

General Corporate Hospitality

At this hospital, in addition to the arrangements detailed via our corporate webpages, we invite members of our hospital Medical Advisory Committee to an annual dinner. The dinner generally costs around £1,000.

Financial Interests

There are no consultants with financial interests in equipment used or services and facilities operated within or at our hospital.

Services Arrangements

Dr Prasanna Kumari, Consultant Microbiologist, provides the hospital with microbiology support and receives a quarterly payment of £2,100 for doing so.
