Introduction

Consultants are critical to each BMI Healthcare hospital. However in common with most private healthcare operators, BMI Healthcare does not employ these consultants. Instead, consultants working in our hospitals are essentially self-employed practitioners who see and treat patients at our hospitals under the terms of our 'credentialing' or 'practising privileges' policy.

It is important that we are transparent about our relationship with our consultants and therefore via our corporate webpages and below, we have set out some of the ways in which we work together.

Higher Value Services

Consultants are charged £23 per hour for using consulting rooms at this hospital, except in relation to NHS patients.

We charge £425 per room per month for consultants using space for their own medical secretaries, plus the costs of any postage.

Lower Value Services

We provide a number of support services to our consultants, for which we do not make a charge. Further details are provided via our corporate webpages.

General Corporate Hospitality

At this hospital, we provide general corporate hospitality as detailed via our corporate webpages.

Financial Interests

Mr Raman Dega, Mr Nicholas Morgan and Mr Callum Clark, Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeons, jointly own extracorporeal shock wave therapy equipment, paying for hospital facilities when using this equipment.

Services Arrangements

Drs Berge Azadian and Hugo Donaldson, Consultant Microbiologists, provide the hospital with microbiology and infection prevention and control support. They are each paid an annual fee of £10,000 for this support.
