Introduction

Consultants are critical to each BMI Healthcare hospital. However in common with most private healthcare operators, BMI Healthcare does not employ these consultants. Instead, consultants working in our hospitals are essentially self-employed practitioners who see and treat patients at our hospitals under the terms of our 'credentialing' or 'practising privileges' policy.

It is important that we are transparent about our relationship with our consultants and therefore via our corporate webpages and below, we have set out some of the ways in which we work together.

Higher Value Services

Consultants are charged £20 per hour for using consulting rooms at this hospital and £16 per hour (plus VAT) for using our medical secretarial services, except in relation to NHS patients.

Lower Value Services

We provide a number of support services to our consultants, for which we do not make a charge. Further details are provided via our corporate webpages.

General Corporate Hospitality

At this hospital, we provide general corporate hospitality as detailed via our corporate webpages.

Financial Interests

Dr Shirley, Consultant Neurophysiologist, owns equipment at the hospital used for nerve conduction studies. The hospital pays a fee for use of this equipment.

Services Arrangements

Drs Alan Feerick, Ed Cowley, Matthew Dolling, Neil Hall, Lisa Milligan, Pulak Paul, Som Sarkar, Dan Harvey, Paul Candler, Steve Gill, Ndu Okonkwo, Mark Ehlers, Richard Sherman and Andrew Sharman, Consultant Anaesthetists/Intensivists, 'staff' (from a consultant perspective) and provide on-call cover and 24/7 availability for the hospital's intensive care unit. The hospital pays £25,000 each year, plus £25,000 each month for this. The consultants also receive a fee on a sliding scale basis for each patient attended to in the unit.
