Evidence that previous anaesthetics have led to serious adverse events or complications. A patient who has an unstable mental condition and is currently receiving psychiatric treatment.

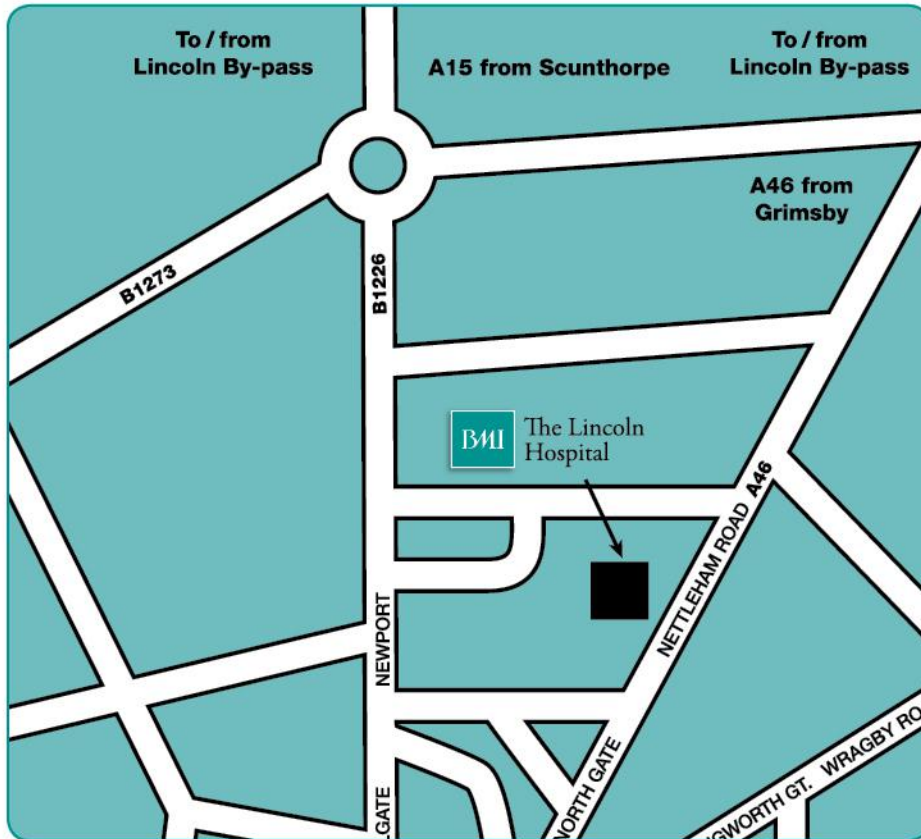
Local PoLCV policies including prior approval where necessary must also be adhered to.
